The annual meeting of the North Central Texas Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts has been scheduled for **Wednesday, April 16, 2025. Registration will begin at 10:00 am, and the cost of registration will be \$30.00.** The meeting will be held at the John Bunker Sands Wetland Center at 655 Martin Lane, Combine, Texas. The meeting will begin with a tour and overview of the Center.

The John Bunker Sands Wetland Center was established in October 2010. It was founded as the education component of a public-private partnership between the [North Texas Municipal Water District](#) and [The Rosewood Corporation](#) to construct a 2,000-acre man-made wetland called the [East Fork Water Reuse Project](#).

The Hunt/Sands family members of The Rosewood Corporation and the water district agreed as part of their partnership to provide a nature center named in honor of the late John Bunker Sands. Bunker was a wetland conservationist and holistic ranch manager.

Since we have not had the opportunity to meet for some time, it has been several years since we have collected dues which are \$25.00.
